In the event of an emergency, Grand Village will have a communications designee that will call the primary emergency contact of each resident to keep them updated on the situation and any pertinent information regarding their loved one's status. It is the responsibility of the primary emergency contact to notify and relay the information to family and friends. As you can image, during an emergency staff time is critical and needs be focused on communicating with each residents' primary contact. If you are the primary contact, thank you in advance for your help in reducing inbound calls during an emergency.
